

Analysis of Maternity Health Program Evaluation by Using of Comprehensive Evaluation Model (CIPPI) – Tabriz, 1389

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Abstract

Background and Objectives: In all health systems maternity health program has an important situation for its grant effects and the evaluation of this program, constantly was at attendance of managers and policy makers of countries. For these reasons the current study wanted to analyze maternity health program by focus on evaluation process accordance to evaluation comprehensive model (CIPPI), in Eastern Azerbaijan.

Material and Methods: This study is a descriptive cross-sectional study and its data collected by qualitative methods. Researchers by referring to all of service delivery levels and interview with process owners and customers, and review of documents focused on program and its evaluation process and analyzed it, and then evaluation results compared with CIPPI model.

Results: The yielded results from comparison of this program evaluation by CIPPI model indicate that from 24 analyzed items in 5 dimensions of this program, only 5 items measured completely, 5 items measured partially and 14 item didn't measured ever.

Conclusion: By attention to obtained results from this study we could conclude that current model of maternity health evaluation program in Eastern Azarbaiejan has a notable gap with an optimal evaluation program and the need for revise of this program according to efficient and effective evaluation models is felt.
